

STATE SETS OCT. 2 HEARING DATE ON DELTA/CHERRY TREE PURCHASE





Updates related to Delta Dental's recent acquisition of Cherry Tree Dental:

Office of the Commissioner of Insurance: WDA submitted written comments to the state Office of the Commissioner of Insurance, which is reviewing corporate restructuring plans filed by Delta Dental of Wisconsin that appear to be related to the Cherry Tree purchase. Our letter details concerns about potential conflicts of interest and questions whether the purchase of dental practices is an appropriate use of the premiums paid to Delta by consumers. A July 2 statement from the ADA was also shared outlining the American Dental Association's concerns about the purchase. The OCI will hold a public hearing on Delta Dental's filing. As soon as we know a time, date and place, that information will be shared so that concerned dentists may attend and share their thoughts.

There will also be an opportunity to submit written comments, and those details will be shared, as well.

Legislative Advocacy Committee: The Delta/Cherry Tree transaction was the subject of a great deal of discussion at the last meeting of the WDA Legislative Advocacy Committee. WDA's government affairs team and member dentists have spoken with several state lawmakers who share our concerns, and we have options to explore related to legislative protections for patients and providers. More information will be shared as the WDA's legislative strategy progresses.

Department of Justice: The WDA submitted a letter to the Wisconsin Department of Justice asking that attorneys monitor the OCI review process. The letter requests that DOJ keep close watch to ensure that the business arrangement does not result in unfair disadvantages for patients or providers.

Trustee Report

A lot has occurred since our last trustee report that has frustrated our members. We all were shocked when we learned that Delta Dental purchased Cherry Tree Dental and we wondered how this could have happened. Aside from dealing with the effects of COVID, I have never heard from more individuals in Region 3.

The WDA stepped up to the plate to answer the numerous phone calls and questions from our members during these tumultuous times and kept members informed every step of the way. Many of us were surprised to hear that the law to allow non-dentists to own dental practices passed over 30 years ago and that we were one of only a handful of states in the U.S. that allows this practice. The WDA has emailed all members excellent Q&As to help all of us better understand the situation. They have explored all avenues in ways we can get involved; keeping open lines of communication with the ADA General Counsel, the Attorney General, the DEB, and the DOJ, and have also explored avenues to propose new legislation that might affect this process in the future. The most important thing is to ensure that this new ownership does not change or impede patient care in any way. The WDA will continue to keep its members informed.

The ADA has also come under much scrutiny and the Interim Executive Director Betsy Shapiro is working tirelessly to "right the ship". Betsy Shapiro, the ADA Board of Trustees and the Finance Committee, are working together to deliver a balanced budget. The ADA President Elect, Richard Risoto has a good vision for the future of the ADA; we will be in good hands moving forward.

Again, we applaud the team at the WDA for their ability to navigate and manage everything from communications to member renewals while dealing with the Salesforce/ Fontiva database transfer- the WDA has maintained excellent membership numbers throughout this process and they will continue to work hard behind the scenes for all members. Our wonderful Executive Director, Mark Paget, has announced his retirement after almost 20 years in the role. After the board reviewed and interviewed multiple applicants, we have offered the job to a very worthy applicant. Stay tuned to hear the big announcement in upcoming weeks. The new ED will be a good fit for the WDA- someone that brings fresh ideas, who is passionate about our organization, and will continue to provide value to the members of the WDA. We are excited to see what the future holds.

The WDAISC Board has been interviewing candidates for President as Mara Roberts is also retiring at the end of this year. The two finalists were interviewed at the August 8th WDAISC Board meeting and the new President will be announced shortly.

We hope that many of you were able to enjoy a day at the Milwaukee County Zoo. We have many upcoming events, so please check the GMDA calendar and join in the fun. We hope to see many of you at an event in the near future.


